3.0 Report from the Chairman of the Council

Cllr B Brothwell confirmed that it had been another successful year although Parish Council funds were limited.

The Village continues to look attractive throughout the year and the Christmas event was successful and well attended.

4.0 Observations from County Cllr C Barnfather

Cllr Barnfather reported the following;

- speed reduction sign was now in place
- Nott's CC are going to repaint the railings around the Linby Docks.
- funding of £500 towards the cost of the Open Gardens event in June 2011 had been received from Nott's CC.
- Nott's CC have visited the Village to establish the number of damaged York flag stones. 111 flag stones (65 square metres) have been identified as requiring replacement. Funding availability/options are to be discussed by the Parish Council.
- Proposals for shelving in the Heritage Centre to be submitted to Cllr Barnfather to establish if any funding is available.

5.0 Report from the Delegates

a) Sir Julian Cahn

Cllr C Hardstaff explained that the accommodation currently has a good rate of occupancy. A successful Royal Wedding event had generated £120 for charity.

b) Enterprise Group

Cllr S Mayes informed the meeting that it had been a successful year and around £3,500 was raised at the Bonfire Night event.
