2.0 Election of Chair

4.0 Election of Delegates

Papplewick & Linby Village Hall

Cllr Wyn Lewis was nominated by Cllr Denise Ireland and seconded by Cllr Elaine Tunstall.

Following on from last year's AMPC Cllr Lewis advised they had been able to resolve the issues regarding retrieving the invested monies and reported that plans have been drawn up to make alterations to the Village Hall to maximise the space available. He commented that wedding books had been low but are starting to improve. He advised that due to the passing of Bob Brothwell there is now a vacancy for a Chairman, which is in hand. He advised the Treasurer Nicola Kerry will continue to carry out payroll and pension duties, Village Hall Manager, Kathryn Holmes will carry out the day to day duties with guidance from Phil Robinson. Cllr Lewis advised the proposal to extend the car park is no longer an option due to missing out on purchasing a small piece of land outside of the front of the building. This would have given an access to another area in order to extend the carpark.
