Public Consultation on the Draft Plan 12:00 noon Monday 18th June 2018 to 12:00 noon Monday 30th July 2018

As you may be aware Linby Parish Council are leading on the production of a Neighbourhood Plan for the entire Parish of Linby. The area was designated by Gedling Borough Council on the 25th April 2016.

This pre-submission consultation is a continuation of the consultation to date, which has led to the current draft Neighbourhood Plan. We want to hear from you, please give your views on any of the policies in the draft Plan and any other comments you would like to make.

It is very important to the process that you (and any other members of the household or community over the age of 16 years) indicate acceptance or otherwise of the Plan and if you wish changes to be made, to make those known to inform the final Plan to be sent for Examination. When it is adopted any planning application in the village will be judged against the Neighbourhood Plan.

Hard copies of the Neighbourhood Plan have been placed at:

- Brook Farm, Main Road, Linby; and
- The Village Hall, Linby Lane, Papplewick.
