## 2.0 Approval of the 2023 APA Minutes

The minutes of the March 2023 APA were approved by the Parish Council. The minutes were signed by Cllrs E Tunstall and W Lewis.

#### 3.0 Report from the Chair

Cllr Ireland gave an overview of the year:

The PC undertook a major project to develop the Heritage Centre using S106 monies including installing water mains on site, cobbling the road surface up to Heritage Centre, creating a hardstanding for the picnic bench and planting wildflower seeds. Special thanks to Cllr Lewis for all his hard work on the project.

We continue to make use of the Lengthsman scheme – thanks to Andy for the work he does in and around the parish.

The PC held a Barn dance last year to commemorate the Coronation of King Charles. We held another successful Carols around the Tree event with money raised being donated to the Nottinghamshire Hospice.

Unfortunately, the Bonfire event last year was cancelled due to adverse weather conditions.

Flooding is having a massive impact in the parish. The PC held a meeting with NCC and the Developers at the Top Wighay site to address these issues. We have also employed a Flood Specialist to look at the drainage on the site. Severn Trent Water have cleared drains in the village due to sewerage running down the footpaths on several occasions.

Traffic and speeding continue to be an issue in the parish. Potholes in the parish are a problem – Waterloo Island potholes are repaired but soon reappear.

Work to build multi-million pound County Council office at Top Wighay started last year. The PC continue to employ Hannah, Planning Consultant to make robust responses on key issues.

#### The year ahead:

- A Puffin crossing in the village has been agreed by NCC Highways
- A crossing at the Linby Lane layby (near Moor Pond Woods) has been agreed by NCC Highways
- Installation of a 2-seater bench at the Heritage Centre
- Footpath repairs in the parish using CIL (Community Infrastructure Levy)
- Bonfire event, weather permitting
- D-Day 80, 6th June a beacon will be lit at Top Cross. All welcome.
