LINBY PARISH COUNCIL

ADVERTISING WITHIN A CONSERVATION VILLAGE POLICY

- 1. Any advertising on Parish Council property may only be displayed with written authority from Linby Parish Council, although generally permission will not be given to advertising benefitting business or private interests.
- 2. Advertising must only be for information pertinent to the community, or in support of community events.
- 3. Adverts must be removed within 2 days following an event.
- 4. The period of display is to be agreed with Linby Parish Council
- 5. Adverts must be in keeping with the area
- 6. No obscene or offensive language or images are to be used
- 7. No political adverts are permitted
- 8. The Parish Council strongly disapproves of all forms of fly posting, which it considers may have a significant adverse impact on the local environment. The Council will generally adopt a pro-active policy of removing fly posting, in particular in the following circumstances:
 - Any fly posting on trees and other structures will be removed immediately
 - Advertisements for any events to be held outside of the village will be removed immediately, unless **agreed** previously by Council

This policy is to be enforced by the Council. Any advertising found without written permission will be removed.

Consent from Linby Parish Council does not imply that a planning consent from Gedling Borough Council would be granted for the advertising media being used.
